- **Article I: Student Group Name**
 - Student Relays Committee
- **Article II: Purpose/Objectives**
 - Student Relays Committee is an organization formed with the intent to connect students at the University of Kansas with opportunities related to track and field and cross country at the collegiate level. Specifically, these opportunities include marketing, volunteering, and outreach of track and field/cross country events. The emphasis of the organization is on preparing for the annual Kansas Relays in the spring, a historic part of the Lawrence community that brings together high schoolers and college athletes from across the country to participate. Through engaging in the planning and management of a large-scale event like the Kansas Relays, students will gain experience to prepare them for life after college. Moreover, the work of students in the committee helps to preserve the history and tradition associated with the yearly track and field event.
- **Article III: Membership**
 - Membership is open to students currently enrolled at the University of Kansas
 - Members must attend monthly meetings of organization and volunteer for Kansas Athletics cross country and track meets
 - Volunteers must help with the operations of the events and contribute with the ideas on improving the events
- **Article IV: Officers and Duties**
 - All officers of the group must be returning members of the committee and be in good standing with the university
 - Advisors: Josh Williamson and Debbie Luman
 - Serve as points of contact between KU Athletics and the Student Relays Committee
 - Ensure proper fulfillment of roles by officers, volunteers, and committee members
 - President:
 - Re-register student group each year
 - Provide information for volunteering opportunities to the group
 - Oversee Vice Presidents and committee as a whole to ensure success of outreach events

- Maintain records of usernames and passwords for social media and email accounts
- Vice President of Marketing:
 - Provide input in the design of the poster and overall branding for the promotion of the Kansas Relays
 - Research avenues to better promote the Kansas Relays
 - Lead distribution of flyers for volunteering and SRC meetings across campus
- Vice President of Sales:
 - Lead team for obtaining food donations for the KU Relays, and be point of contact for President regarding progress
 - Must work with President to determine an appropriate list of vendors to visit for food donations
- Vice President of Communication:
 - Controls social media accounts, distributing information relevant to the group and its aforementioned objectives and purposes at their own discretion or the discretion of the president
- **By-Laws of the Group**
 - No membership dues will be required for involvement in the organization
 - New members may join the organization at any point during the course of the year.
 - Officers may be dismissed from their roles by the advisor if said officer(s) do(es) not meet expectations.
 - Officers for the following year will be chosen by advisor and present officers
